





ABOUT MMUN

Montessori Model United Nations combines the scholarship and global citizenry of Model UN with the pedagogical insights of Maria Montessori. It is a unique opportunity for children ages 9 through age 15, to become delegates, ambassadors of UN member states who are working together to solve the world's most pressing crises. Delegates research and prepare for the conference by studying the UN, the country they are representing, and the topics covered in their chosen committee. At the conference, delegates negotiate from their country's position on the topic during committee session. The committees and their relevant topics are taken directly from the UN agenda. MMUN follows the six committees of the General Assembly and the Security Council. In the Security Council, delegates might discuss Somalia or the annexation of Crimea. Delegates prepare for these negotiations through researching the position of their represented country on these topics. They learn what the country has or has not done in relation to the issue and present a solution to the issue being discussed. While at the conference, the student stays in the role of delegate, representing the point of view of their country, not their own, to negotiate with other countries to write a draft resolution and hopefully reach consensus to adopt the draft resolution. MMUN provides more than a UN simulation and powerful scholastic experience. It opens the eyes of the participants to the global issues we all face as collective humans. Then through their work as ambassadors, it gives them a voice in creating change. Not only are they given a platform but they are creating solutions to these challenging contemporary issues. Our goal is to inspire youth to create a better world and the first step is awareness and empowerment.
