



WHAT IS PRESS CORPS? MMUN CONFERENCES 2027

Press Corps reporters represent a national or international news agency instead of a country. In preparation for this role, reporters write an editorial instead of a position paper.

During the conference, reporters inform the conference about actions in the committees through a Press Corps Blog and Live Press Briefings.

Unlike MMUN delegates, the Press Corps does not have a specific agenda. Instead, reporters choose committee topics that they would like to report on. It is fun and engaging work.

Each news agency picks one of three topics from a Topic 1 category and one of three topics from a Topic 2 category.

EXAMPLE The *Korea Herald* must write one editorial on a topic from **Topic List 1** (for example, *Engaging Boys and Young Men in Gender Equality*) and a second editorial on a topic from **Topic List 2** (for example, *The Question of Palestine*).

Each news agency must select two topics - one from Topic List 1 and one from Topic List 2 - and create two editorials.
