

Where is the ModelUN.News Academy Summer Program held?

The daily sessions of the **ModelUN.News Summer Program** are held at NYC's prestigious Columbia University. We will also be visiting a podcast and radio recording studio, as well as a television studio, and will enjoy a guided tour of the United Nations. During the week-long **ModelUN.News Summer Program**, you'll stay at dorms on the campus, meet hundreds of other students from all over the world and get to spend a week in one of the most dynamic cities of the world—New York.

Are all the students at the ModelUN.News Academy Summer Program my age?

The ages of the students attending are from 10-18. Students younger than 12 must have attended at least one session of a Model UN Conference.

Is the Summer Program open only to students from the USA?

No, students from all countries are invited. That gives you a chance to learn about different cultures, meet other students with backgrounds different than yours and maybe even create lifelong friendships.

What are the dates of the ModelUN.News Summer Program?

Three sessions are being offered this summer in NYC:
July 16 - July 22, July 23 - July 29, July 30 - August 5

When are the registration deadlines and how do I register?

How much does it cost?

Early bird registration fee for the ModelUN.News Summer Program is \$2500 (inclusive of transfers, room, board, UN Tour and selected evening entertainment). Tours of other NYC sights may be arranged at additional cost. Flights are not included.
