General Assembly First Committee

Topic: Nuclear Disarmament

The General Assembly, reminding all nations of the threat nuclear weapons pose to all of Mankind,

Deeply concerned about the amount of nuclear weapons in the world,

Alarmed by the power and destructive effects of nuclear arms,

Confident that by implementing this resolution we can greatly diminish the risk of further nuclear disasters

- 1 Calls upon nuclear states to reduce their nuclear arsenal by 4% each year over a course of 25 years;
- 2 Recommends annual inspections of all signatories as well as suspicious countries under reasonable grounds that lead to increased semi-annual in the case that a country is found to be developing nuclear weapons;
- 3 Encourages countries to give trade incentives to nations signing and adhering by this resolution;
- 4 Strongly suggests the reinvestment and directions of previous funds and materials to peaceful purposes and the production of clean energy;
- 5 Draws the attention of countries to the arming nations and increasing instability of the middle eastern region;
- 6 Urges an NWFZ to be implemented in the area to ensure stability in that region.
