Resolution UNSC/2.1

Recognizing that there are most likely over eight states with nuclear weapons,

Fully Aware of the fact that there are 20,530 known nuclear weapons,

Noting with regret that not all of the countries have signed the NPT or the CTBT,

Expressing with hope that the world will be free of nuclear weapons by 2020,

- 1. Recommends monthly searches to assure that nuclear weapons are not being manufactured;
- 2. Further recommends that all member states of the UN sign the NPT as well as the CTBT;
- 3. Declares accordingly to annually decrease the number of nuclear weapons stockpiles; and
- 4. Strongly condemns the use of nuclear weapons by terrorist organizations.
