Topic: Social Development Rights of Persons with Disabilities

Taking into consideration that the disabled have not been treated fairly for many years,

Fully aware that most of the world is trying to make a better place for the social development of disabled people,

Aware that poverty is caused by unemployment,

Realizing that explosives are one of the problems that causes many disabilities,

Recognizing that education is a major problem because the disabled have special needs and some schools cannot comply,

1. Strongly recommends that member states raise donated funds that provide foundations for disabled people and their families;
2. Declares that disabled persons should have fair income and employment that they can do to show their strengths;
3. Reaffirms that disabled people can practice their culture without possible or further discrimination;

4. Requests that disabled people can have access to every service that they may need;
5. Recommends that all member states' governments give high level education to disabled people for all ages and schools;
6. Draws attention to cost for high priced equipment, medication and other items needed by disabled people to be lowered;
7. Recommends every child born with or who develops a disability has access to affordable and accessible education and an unpaid internship in high school;
8. Strongly recommends races, sports games, radio, newspaper activities and apps to raise money for disabled people;
9. Further invites member states to provide affordable housing;
10. Authorizes utilizing funds raised by the games and app for building special schools with accommodations for disabled children.
