- 1. Calls Upon the United Nations to help finance schools and communities to teach a variety of religions to generations to come, which includes learning to respect other religions;
- 2. Requests the United Nations to fund this project to build churches and have schools and communities teach different religions;
- 3. Further requests the United Nations to fund different governments to allow the right to conversion;
- 4. Trusts the International Religious Liberty Association (I.R.L.A) to help raise public awareness promoting religious freedom to decrease forced religious teachings;
- 5. Calls upon the peace N.G.O Forum that has helped resolve the war between Israel and Palestine to help prevent religious wars from occurring around the world;
- Supports Freedom House which is a non- governmental organization that supports the developing of nations that suffer from the lack of media, expression and Human Rights freedom;
- 7. Encourages large NGO's such as P.N.G.O.F, I.R.L.A and F.H. to continue stride for more freedom of religion or belief; and
