

Resolution UNSC/1.2

Co-Sponsors: Afghanistan, Argentina, Azerbaijan, France, Germany, Guatemala, Pakistan, Russian Federation, Rwanda, Togo, and United Kingdom.

Topic: Situation in Israel-Palestine

Taking into account that Israel intercepts all packages meant for Palestinians,

Recognizing that 2014 is the UN international year of peace in Palestine,

Deeply regretting that all peace negotiation efforts to end this 66-year dispute have not succeeded,

Stressing the fact that millions of Palestinians are displaced in refugee camps,

1. Encourages the UN to give Palestine full state status;
2. Trusts that the Israeli government provides Israel-Palestine with land to create separate Jewish and Arab States;
3. Recommends that Israel and Palestine create a neutral zone in Jerusalem, as it the Holy Land of both Jews and Arabs.
4. Suggests the UN to provide peacekeepers to maintain borders in Israel-Palestine;

5. Requests the Palestinians in the Gaza Strip to move to the West Bank and that all Israelis currently living in the West Bank to move to other parts of Israel;
6. Further requests funding from member states that are able to fund materials to build water purification plants in Israel;
7. Strongly recommends the eradication of all terrorist groups in Israel and Palestine, through creating separate Jewish and Arab states; and
8. Urges member states to provide Palestine with humanitarian and financial aid.
