The Third Committee of the General Assembly, fulfilling clauses and causes stated in the United Nations charter which include promoting decent work, generating worldwide commitment in support of children, and improving education in developing countries,
Believing that education is key in preventing humanitarian violations, abolishing child labor, breaking the poverty cycle, and helping to strengthen the global economy through jobs,

Alarmed by the status of children in many countries and seeking to improve the quality of children’s rights,

Bearing in mind that many countries have insufficient funding,

Realizing the urgency of this issue and attempting to implement quick solutions to maximize its efficiency,

1. Designates the following program as a Non-Governmental Organization;

2. Expresses appreciation for funds and donations to prepare teams to restore and renovate old buildings into safe learning environments for children and adults;
3. Further recommends mobile education to be provided to children and adults who live too far away or have difficult routes to the nearest school;
4. Fulfills the needs for funding from other relevant Non-Governmental Organizations and fundraisers such as sporting and musical events;
5. Encourages other subsidiary ordinates to donate;
6. Expresses its appreciation to volunteers from the United Nations and the general public, to become teachers and to train teachers in underdeveloped places;
7. Establishes trade and tax-deductible donations and successful launch of restoration of schools and mobile education;
8. Encourages people to have a say in their protection and their rights to prevent uprisings; and
9. Gathers citizen's opinions through various polling methods.
