Topic: Situation in Ukraine

The Security Council meeting on November 16-18, 2014 in Zhengzhou, China in response to the situation in Ukraine and moving toward peace and security,

Aware of civilians impacted in the Ukraine because of the conflict,

Taking note that countries like Russia, Ukraine and part of the European Union are losing money,

Noting the toll the conflict has taken on the civilians on both sides of the conflict,

- 1. Approves of opening a trade agreement between The Russian Federation and other countries who have been hit economically in order to maintain stability;
- 2. Calls upon having both leaders of the Ukraine and the rebel group to meet up to talk about a possible solution in New York to talk with other countries in the United Nations;
- 3. Requests helping civilians who are being harmed due to the situation by giving them food, supplies and medicine they need.
