3. Further considers placing more schools near villages so that women do not put themselves in danger on their way to school;
4. Encourages developed nations to work with developing nations to set up education programs in order to enable women to get better jobs upon reaching adulthood;
5. Recommends the development of programs to aid in the development of educational opportunities for women;
6. Calls upon an international NGO for the protection of women;
7. Supports the creation of education programs in secondary schools about running and working for businesses;
8. Request for all member states to provide free and accessible education to all of its population;
9. Recommends raising awareness of the issue of advancement of women and supports teaching about gender equality in schools;
10. Encourages member states to support equal pay;
