Topic: Financing Peacekeeping Missions - Africa

Fully aware of the sacrifices peacekeepers make while working in dangerous areas,

Aware of the urgent need for peacekeeping missions in Africa,

Having considered that the Sudanese and Democratic Republic of Congo's government wishes to remove the peacekeepers,

Fully aware that we need to take action and reduce the budgets from the existing missions in order to create a new Peacekeeping Mission,

- 1. Encourages the concept of inter-mission cooperation, the act of two or more missions sharing resources to be used, to fulfill the required budget of the new mission;
- 2. Urges countries to contribute troops and equipment to the noble cause of peacekeeping;
- 3. Recommends the following budgetary reductions:
