Deeply concerned by the fact that there are 1.2 billion people living in the world on less than \$1.25 a day,

We are fully aware that 1 out of 5 of the UK's population is living below the official poverty line experiencing life at the daily struggle.

- 1. Encourage that shelter should be built for people who do not have for themselves;
- 2. Further recommends to have free education and vaccines in the shelters to prevent poverty in their future lives;
- 3. Affirming all children will be taken care of inside these shelters with food and all nutritious items;
- 4. Reminds we will create a website to raise money to make the shelters in which people will be living inside these shelters;
- 5. Calls for the creation of more public schools.
