Topic: Financing Peacekeeping Missions –War and Disaster

<u>Deeply conscious</u> of the fact that a considerable underfunding exists in the fifth committee,

<u>Aware of</u> the need for USD\$90 million to create a new mission; this must be achieved by implementing budgets cuts in UNIFIL (Lebanon), MINSUTAH (in Haiti), and UNMIK (Kosovo),

<u>Taking into consideration</u> the devastating consequences of a failure to carry out and fulfill the missions' goals,

- Encourages the fifth committee to reduce the UNIFIL Military and Police
 Personnel Costs budget by USD\$34 million;
- 2. Urging that USD\$1 million is cut from the Air Transportation budget in UNIFIL;
- 3. Calls upon the fifth committee to reduce the budget of the Military and Police

 Personnel Costs in MINUSTAH by USD\$50 million; and
- 4. Requests to remove USD\$5 million in UNMIK from the Civilian Personnel Costs.
