UN Water

Topic: Access to Water

Co-Sponsors: Kingdom of Sweden, Republic of Argentina, Republic of France, Republic of Azerbaijan, Republic of Italy, Federal Republic of Germany, Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Russian Federation, Federative Republic of Brazil, Kingdom of Thailand.

Noting with regret that the problem of access to water has affected 2.4 billion people who do not have access to water or sanitation,

Reaffirming the Millennium Development Goal number seven,

Noting with satisfaction nations have been working hard to face the challenge of access to water,

Bearing in mind that the United Nations face financial issues but still want to be helpful,

- 1.Calls upon the United Nations to advocate for the countries that do not have access to water;
- 2.Call for publicity and education in towns and cities containing the problem;
- 3.Strongly condemns countries without fresh and clean water access and encourages those nations to correct the problem;
- 4.Recommends turning seawater into drinking water using saline water desalination technology;
- 5.Expresses its hope for upgrading treatment plans;
- 6.Supports the building of dams used to store water;

7.Suggests formulation of a long-term plan for a water resource network.
