Understanding that armed conflict contributes to food insecurity,

Alarmed by the large amount of malnutrition in the world,

Keeping in mind the effects climate change has on agriculture,

Draws attention to the fact that agricultural products can be used as medicine,

- 1. Encourages member states to open more food banks in their countries;
- 2. Trusts member states to provide proper schooling including food and climate change education;
- 3. Calls upon the FAO to provide nutritional support to countries in need;
- 4. Urges governments to provide agricultural jobs to those in poverty;
- Recommends developed countries to give loans to underdeveloped countries in exchange for goods;
- 6. Expresses its hope that food transportation to rural areas is an opportunity to create jobs for those in poverty;

- 7. Further requests the WFP to create a funding plan to give long term help to countries in need;
- 8. Calls upon countries to educate children on how to reduce food waste;
- 9. Recommends countries to communicate amongst each other to further develop agriculture.
