Topic: Food security for all

The Committee,

Declaring food security is when people do not have equal access to healthy and nutritious foods,

Alarming that one seventh of the earth is currently suffering from chronic food insecurity,

1. Requests the UN to support us with, first, hiring employees to help countries with their main attractions;
2. Reminds the UN should get a bit of the money in these industries;
3. Calls upon raising a charity for "Food Bank";
4. Encourages the countries which need food to apply for food in "Food Bank" each week;
5. Recommends the highly developed counties to donate food to the Food Bank on a specific day every week;
6. Further recommends the UN use the money mentioned earlier to buy food on a specific day every week, after the Food Bank got the food, the nutritionists will choose the relatively high-quality foods and arrange them according to the applications handed in earlier;

7. Calls upon for employees to transport these foods to the developing countries which has applied for food;
8. Declares accordingly that if a developing country gets the food donated by the other countries, the countries that donated these foods will get a discount when they are purchasing the specialities of the country that gets the food;
9. Expresses its hope that if the countries which have been helped by the Food Bank get some extra food, please donate it to the Food Bank in return to help the countries in need.
