Topic: Leaving No One Behind

Alarmed by the fact that many people are being left behind, and don't have access to basic human needs,

Deeply concerned that some people do not have access to infrastructure,

Deeply concerned by the alarming numbers of people in poverty lacking education and facing discrimination,

Keeping in mind the needs of countries,

Believing countries can make a difference,

Alarmed by the amount of racial discrimination spreading across the globe,

Deeply concerned that people are getting discriminated against and have been left behind,

Alarmed by the consumption of natural resources each year,

Bearing in mind that global warming can cause harm to the ecosystem,

Fundamental Human Needs

- 1. Encourages NGOs and governments to provide basic needs like water, food, clothes, and shelter for people who can't afford to do so themselves;
- 2. Calls upon governments and NGOs to create necessary infrastructure for less populated areas;
- 3. Requests that governments and NGOs support educational foundations;

- 4. Further invites cities to create local food banks to cease the need for food;
- 5. Recommends governments to create more economic opportunities;

Fundraising, Awareness & Collaboration

- 6. Recommends countries and NGOs to provide Financial assistance;
- 7. Strongly advises countries acknowledge climate change and its detrimental effects;
- 8. Encourage countries to work with local Nonprofits to raise awareness and funding for refugees and those living in poverty;
- 9. Advises countries to provide their citizens with PSA's so everyone is on the same page;
- 10. Requests that countries fundraise for safer housing for those in poverty;
- 11. Urges countries governments and other individuals to advocate for and fund healthcare;

Environmental Impact

- 12. Calls upon businesses and factories to place restrictions on their CO2 emissions;
- 13. Advises countries to cut down on the consumption of natural resources;
- 14. Urges countries and energy businesses to make sustainable energy more accessible to all;

Discrimination

- 15. Urges everyone to confront discrimination throughout the community;
- 16. Encourages governments and NGO's to campaign against discrimination;
- 17. Acknowlegges the fact that people, governments, and NGO's should help others who are experiencing discrimination.
