Topic: Protection of global climate for present and future generations of humankind

Observing that climate change is at a point where it needs to be reduced and many are not aware of this or just don't care, educating future generations will raise awareness and this could lead to better society around the world, a lot of countries can't afford renewable energy in that case,

The Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions

- 1. Calls upon immediate action against climate change with the help with fellow nations, also the recognition of attention to the homes affected by climate change;
- Draws attention to the fact that one of the largest sources of GHGs is the pursuit of space travel, by reducing the amount and frequency of space travel it would greatly reduce the global GH emissions;

- 3. Advises the government to place taxes on coal, using such funds to donate to clean energy companies;
- 4. Further recommending more plant-based foods and items using vertical farming;
- 5. Emphasizes the situation will be necessary to accomplish climate change for the better;

Community and Education

- 6. Calls upon wealthier countries to donate some of their tax funds to educate other countries;
- 7. Affirms that we must start using renewable energy;
- 8. Advises to educate children and adults alike on climate change;
- 9. Expresses how people encourage others to stop climate change from spreading;
- Encourages people to stop using nuclear and other sorts of non-eco-friendly resources from getting into the ocean;
- 11. Acknowledges ideas for reducing climate change, encouraging recycling for plastic bottles and such, directs creating funds for helping children learn about climate change then to help others and teach those who don't understand;
- 12. Recognizes the failed solutions so other countries don't use the idea;
- 13. Demands people to reduce carbon emissions and CO₂;
- 14. Emphasizes countries to encourage people to use reusable items instead of plastic items;

Promote Clean Energy, Renewable Energy and Efficiency

- 15. Encourages to spend more money on planting trees;
- 16. Calls upon more policies on commercial fishing;

- 17. Instructs UN countries to invest in renewable sustainable and clean energy in transports and industry;
- Recommends putting sustainable and reliable energy generators in remote and uninhabitable places such as deserts;
- 19. Strongly encourages countries to use geothermal energy;
- 20. Encourages countries to put hydropower pumps in sewers;

Plastic, Recycling, and Cleaning Up

- 21. Congratulates countries on making more durable plastic water bottles;
- 22. Recommends spending and donating money to plant more trees;
- 23. Demands more beach and sea clean-ups;
- 24. Calls for organizations to make machines that clean the ocean from plastic and such waste that should've been recycled;
- 25. Strongly advises countries to compost leftovers instead of throwing them out;
- 26. Emphasizes countries to encourage people to use reusable items instead of plastic items.
