Topic: Sustainable Development - The Special Situation of Landlocked Developing Countries

Noting with concern LLDCs should try to participate in global trade,
Keeping in mind the lack of investment in the economy within Landlocked Developing countries,
Aware of the fact that LLDCs are at a disadvantage,
Fully aware of the effects energy poverty has on LLDCs citizens,
Noting that a weak economy discourages investors,

Poverty and loss of economy

1. Calls upon the governments of the world to create more economic free trade zones;
2. Recommends countries that border LLDCs support them by bringing supplies;

World trade

3. Declares that LLDCs should be a part of world trade;
4. Recommends partnering countries build public ports and trade pathways that the countries can help develop and maintain;

5. Highly recommends transit countries to partner with LLDCs to help them export and import goods;
6. Strongly condemns sea transit route to be put in place;
7. Accepts the idea of signing treaties with LLDCs;
8. Encourages LLDCs to request assistance from the ODA (official development assistance);
9. Recommends that the cost of shipping exports be lowered;

Investment and economy

10. Reaffirms implementation of the Vienna Program of Action;
11. Encourages more transit countries to port share with neighboring LLDCs;
12. Suggests digitalization to reduce human error;

Energy

13. Recommends to enhance inexpensive energy alternatives;
14. Requests funds to promote solar and wind power resources;
15. Calls upon developed nations to support LLDCs that struggle with energy poverty for awareness;
16. Further invites all UN member states to reduce the cost of clean energy.
