Topic: Empowerment of Rural Women

Noting with deep concern that rural women lack access to job training, land rights and financial resources,

Alarmed by the amount of rural women who are affected by food security,

Acknowledging that in some countries rural women do not have equal rights,

Noting the fact that rural women still do not have equal opportunities,

Believing an NGO will help support rural women in overcoming hunger,

Education and Business Training

- I. Draws attention to women that do not have jobs;
- 2. Requests UN agencies to provide countries with supplies to build more schools in rural areas;
- 3. Requests UN agencies to provide countries with supplies to build more schools in rural areas;

4. Encourages countries to make laws so women can start their own businesses;

Opportunities

- 5. Recommends countries give rural women more representation;
- 6. Acknowledges that rural women require accessible healthcare;
- 7. Calls upon countries that are striving to let women have a vote;
- 8. Emphasizes spreading awareness to rural women about the resources;
- Suggests to countries to create free programs to teach women appropriate skills for their country;
- 10. Encourages countries to make laws so women can start their own businesses;
- 11. Further requests that women have the right to own land;
- 12. Urges countries to provide opportunities for women in the workforce;
- 13. Emphasizes that women need access to educational opportunities;

Food Security

- 14. Requests more food pantries in rural areas for easy access to food;
- 15. Welcomes farmers to open more fruit and vegetables markets in rural areas for a more nutritious diet;
- 16. Expresses our hope for zero hunger;
- 17. Draws attention to how many rural women in poverty;

Equal Rights and Gender Equality

- 18. Calls upon equal pay for men and women;
- 19. Suggests nations give equal funds to men and women;
- 20. Emphasizes the need for marriage rights;
- 21. Encourages countries to allow women to work in male-dominated fields;
- 22. Strongly encourages countries to make laws against gender violence;
- 23. Supports voting rights for rural women;
- 24. Notes that women make up less of the workforce than men;
- 25. Encourages food companies to lower prices of healthy food.
