#### **Topic: Empowerment of Rural Women**

Alarmed by how many women and girls don't have access to quality education,

Fully aware that many women have been subject to sexual abuse,

Deeply concerned about the lack of accessibility to resources for women,

Fully alarmed by the fact that the number of gender-based attacks on women have been increasing,

Realizing the income gap between men and women is unfair for women,

Aware that women in rural areas almost never have access to healthcare,

#### **Education and Jobs for Women**

1. Encourages women to attend educational classes available virtually and in-person;
2. Requests that women and men are paid an equal amount;

3. Supports and endorses NGOs that fund women-owned businesses;
4. Affirms the importance of affordable education;
5. Urges female participation in higher positions;
6. Congratulates women who are attempting to take the steps towards success;
7. Encourages women to expand into male-dominated fields;

### **Violence and Abuse Against Women**

8. Urges governments to enforce laws to protect women's and girl's rights;
9. Directs communities and governments to enforce stricter punishments for violence against women;
10. Advises countries to offer free counseling to people who experience gender based violence;
11. Calls upon countries to develop programs to educate the public on gender inequality;
12. Requires education for girls under the age of 18 who have been subject to abuse;
13. Further requests to educate older women who have not finished school due to violence and abuse;

### **Supporting Rural Women with Housing and Equal Pay**

14. Encourages people to make housing prices equal for all genders;
15. Advises companies to provide housing for women, especially single mothers;
16. Condemns sexual assault in the workplace;

## **Women's Healthcare, Resources, and Rights**

17. Requests that women have equal pay and healthcare;
18. Strongly advises access to equal working conditions;
19. Calls for setting up a virtual and in-person agriculture education system;
20. Endorses getting community electronics, internet, and powerlines into more rural areas;
21. Requests that healthcare centers provide telemedicine to rural communities;
22. Urges countries to empower rural women around the world.
