Topic: Adequate Housing

Alarmed by the fact that because of rent increasing many people have been forced out of their homes - one example of this are the problems happening such as eviction, housing, and additions that have caused about 150 million people to become homeless,

Deeply concerned by the effect inflation has in the rural housing markets,

Deeply concerned at the pollution of major water sources,

Aware that natural disasters are a big problem that come in the way of adequate housing,

Cost

- Encourages member states to provide governmental protection against eviction such as landlords extending eviction dates for people who are struggling with money also including people living in rural areas;
- 2. Urges states to enforce laws that require landlords to extend due dates, depending on the occupation of the current resident;
- 3. Calls upon schooling, internships, employment, and affordable education for all;
- 4. Encourages governments to find the average between high taxes and low taxes due to taxes being too high for many people to pay;

Housing Finance

- 5. Encourages countries and large organizations to donate, support, and fund NGOs (Non Governmental Organizations) that provide extra protection and temporary shelter as requested by individuals and families;
- 6. Recommends microfinance loans as a possible solution to combat inadequate housing;

Requirements of an Adequate House

7. Urges all countries to provide resources to those living in inadequate environments such as crisis centers to help countries recover from crisis and disasters with preparation;

8. Calls for all countries to give affordable education/scholarships to people without access to adequate education or with economic disadvantages.
