Topic: Impact of the Ukraine-Russia conflict on global food security and related matters

Deeply concerned on the amount of Ukrainians dying because of lack of food,

Recognizing the passing of Ukrainians,

Alarmed by the increase of poverty following the Ukraine and Russia conflict, we believe it is an utmost priority that this situation should be addressed,

Recognizing that due to the lack of fertilizers, farmers will not be able to grow enough food,

Fully aware of the increasing starvation globally,

Having considered the undernourishment of the world,

Noting with regret the insufficient information about current food security situations,

Deeply concerned for the millions of those impoverished and hungry,

Aware of the changing numbers of the economy in countries that receive their agricultural products from Ukraine,

Keeping in mind that the war has affected many other countries not only Russia and Ukraine,

Problems in Ukraine

- 1. Calls upon building refugee camps around Ukraine, by providing proper food supply and medical attention prioritizing Ukrainians from financially capable countries;
- 2. Encourages financial aid and support from all nations;
- 3. Further recommends more agricultural infrastructure in Ukraine to increase the building of planting spaces, and the construction of filtering facilities to clean water;
- 4. Considers other countries to help Ukraine farm crops by using high-tech machines;
- 5. Requests countries to export foods to Ukraine and other resources;
- 6. Calls upon other countries to educate more efficient forms of planting to self sustain;

The world's problems

- 7. Notes that more fertilizer warehouses should be placed throughout respective nations;
- 8. Recommends food drives related fundraisers as a way to aid in poverty and lack of resources;
- 9. Requests that a network be created to help distribute food to places with food shortages;
- 10. Encourages everyone to acknowledge the lack of resources related to food and agricultural production and create fundraisers to help those in need;

Global starvation

- II. Notes that MRE's (meals ready to eat) should be distributed to places with food shortages;
- 12. Encourages a global assessment of the food security situation in each nation;
- 13. Emphasizes action towards food security;
- 14. Calls upon financially capable nations to donate funds and resources to food insecure countries;

- 15. Requests proper storage of food;
- 16. Considers freezing excess food;

The global economy

- 17. Recommends the diversification of food and agricultural imports outside of Ukraine and Russia;
- 18. Encourages local governments to strengthen local agriculture in order to cut down transportation costs;
- 19. Considers transferring food from places that are cheaper to places that are more expensive;
- 20. Further requests companies and countries to allow more job opportunities to anyone;
- 21. Calls upon global countries to give financial aid towards refugees.
