## **Ecological Solutions to Water Use Management**

- 1. Urges the creation of Friday lessons at schools on desertification;
- 2. Strongly advises recycling water using rain collectors, filters, water towers, and more;
- 3. Encourages sustainable land management and conservation efforts;
- 4. Supports the promotion of desertification on social media;
- 5. Endorses the creation of policies against desertification;

#### **Education Methods**

- 6. Calls for the creation of educational advertisements on desertification;
- 7. Advises programs for adults to be educated about desertification;

## The Impact of Desertification

- 8. Encourages countries to import soils, seeds, and fertilizers appropriate to areas experiencing land degradation;
- 9. Suggests the use of water filtering and recycling methods;
- 10. Calls upon countries to donate food, water, and compost supplies;
- 11. Promotes more actions towards reforestation;
- 12. Calls upon creating paper out of invasive trees;

## **Helping People Affected by Desertification**

- 13. Suggests building shelters that have desertification supplies;
- 14. Calls for the reuse of plastic;
- 15. Strongly encourages countries to expand forested lands and to create large land restoration programs that plant drought resilient plants;
- 16. Urges reducing the use of fossil fuels.
