- 5. Calls for more plastic recycling plants and factories;
- 6. Urges people and manufacturers alike to help the cause of eradicating plastic pollution;

### Plastic Problems and it's Alternatives

- 7. Acknowledges that plastic has a very big impact on the world;
- 8. Expresses its regrets of not helping fight plastic problems;

## **Educating about Agricultural Plastic**

- 9. Calls upon youth to take good care of our planet and food systems;
- 10. Encourages youth to be educated on plastic waste and food systems;
- 11. Trusts everyone to be responsible with use of plastic;
- 12. Emphasizes with the people affected by microplastics in their food;

### **Plastic Pollution**

- 13. Further reminds that fish are dying in the water due to microplastics;
- 14. Urges the community to not use plastic bags;
- 15. Calls for the community to pick up trash;
- 16. Encourages farmers to use alternative plastics;
- 17. Strongly encourages people to recycle plastics;
