Deeply concerned about the lack of water resources,

Alarmed by the amount of deforestation,

Keeping in mind that climate change is one of the leading causes of desertification,

Plantation Projects

1. Calls upon all nations to create a law reducing carbon emissions by using electric vehicles;
2. Recommends member states to plant more native plants;
3. Suggests member states create more space for forests;
4. Requests member states to rotate crops;
5. Welcomes sustainable land management;
6. Encourages wealthier countries to donate money to poorer countries for farming equipment;

7. Encouraging youth to practice agriculture more often;

Preserving Water

8. Also recommends to form funds to combat desertification;
9. Advises and encourages member states to collect water to preserve land experiencing drought;
10. Further invites importing water into countries;
11. Requests countries to filter rainwater;
12. Calls upon member states to manage their water responsibly;
13. Encourages countries to build wells;
14. Congratulates people who don't waste water;

Working Together to Reduce Fossil Fuels and Climate Change

15. Strongly supports member states to work together to stop desertification by planting trees and reintroducing local flora and fauna;
16. Encourages wealthier member states to fund education to teach the youth about desertification;
17. Recommends wealthy countries to invest more in renewable energy;
18. Calls upon member states to lower the carbon emissions in industrial areas;

Stopping Desertification

19. Accepts changing the feed of animals to reduce carbon emissions;
20. Advises the increase of consequences for illegal deforestation;
21. Further invites countries to naturally regenerate land lost to desertification.
