Enhancing technologies

- 3. Calls upon countries to construct aqueducts to flood water to areas experiencing drought;
- 4. Further requests drought on app that can be created to warn people when their area is prone to natural disasters;

5. Calls upon governments to install bamboo foundations under buildings to help maintain flexibility during earthquakes;
