Topic: Implementation of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification in Those Countries Experiencing Serious Drought and/or Desertification, Particularly in Africa

Alarmed by how many trees are cut down by humans for money,

Considering the amounts of pollution in drainage networks,

Acknowledging the low quality of soil health in areas that are affected by desertification,

Alarmed by the effect of the lack of clean water management,

Education and prioritizing nature

1. Recommends that more trees need to be planted as cutting down trees speeds up desertification;
2. Acknowledges that we need to ensure sustainability for water so that we can plant trees;
3. Urges all organizations and acts to be eco-friendly;

Sustainable practises

4. Calls for more research to be done on desertification so children and adults can get a better education;
5. Requests for sustainable agriculture and development of earth observation technologies;

6. Further recommends farmers to teach people how to plant trees;
7. Further invites people to come and ensure conservative measures to save forests;

Drainage care

8. Calls upon all nations to create strict regulations on desertification;
9. Encourages nations to educate farmers in sustainable irrigation and farming techniques;
10. Urges countries to build more water storage units to use in case of droughts;
11. Advises governments to improve irrigation in the rainforest;

Distribution and ability of clean water

12. Adopts the idea to built wells in places facing droughts;
13. Further recommends using flood water for land that is facing drought and desertification;
14. Suggests that member states that have a good supply of water to support countries in need.
