Topic: Right to Food

Considering the thoughts of people with a lack of resources and food,

Considering the importance of children who need food,

Acknowledging the fact that people are dying of starvation,

Acknowledging that the making and the prices of food are getting more and more expensive due to inflation,

Agriculture

1. Acknowledges the energy and technique in farming;
2. Invites youth to join global farming programs;
3. Suggests adults to introduce youth to the problems of poverty and food scarcity;

4. Underlines the importance of sustainable agriculture;

Youth Interaction

1. Calls upon all schools to grow their own crops;
2. Urges youth to raise awareness of malnutrition;
3. Further requests making youth first priority in terms of food scarcity/severity;
4. Encourages countries to help other countries by trading;

The Importance of Consuming Nutritious Food

1. Encourage governments to increase the income of farm households by funding them;
2. Invite schools and other education systems to teach people about the importance of nutritious foods;
3. Emphasize countries should encourage eco-friendly greenhouses in areas where food is not accessible;
4. Encourages countries to stop using harmful chemicals and use sustainable farming instead;

Food Insecurity and Malnutrition

1. Suggests that countries with more food than others should give some to countries that need it;
2. Advise to reduce general food waste and give to homeless that countries reduce food waste through cautious transportation from food suppliers/companies so that more people can receive food;
3. Urges that factories should be aware of the hygiene of the product and shut down the factory if it is not compliant;
4. Encourages citizens to use local markets to help the local economy;
5. Considers all countries to give less taxes to poor people.
