Acknowledging pollution and how it affects climate change,

Deeply concerned how water sanitation is scarce in many places,

Fully aware that many countries have less water resources,

Deeply concerned with how droughts affect crop growth,

Affirming that not many countries have enough water resources,

Deeply concerned for the high amount of people suffering from the lack of clean water,

#### **Water Technology & Water-Related Diseases**

1. Encourage all nations to promote and teach sustainable water management practices;
2. Encourages all nations to improve the resilience of water systems;

3. Invites scientists all over the world to share information on climate change so that humans will be prepared for challenges due to climate change;
4. Advises companies to renew wasted water through sanitation;
5. Approves banning lobbying;
6. Improve water sanitation technology;

### **Agriculture & Irrigation Tactics**

7. Calls upon all member states of the UN to invest money in WASAG to make innovative water recycling apparatuses in exchange for a return investment;
8. Reminds all nations to reuse wasted and used water;
9. Encourages new water technology and techniques;
10. Further reminds nations to teach their citizens about water illnesses;

### **Upcycling Wastewater, Pollution & Water Sanitation**

11. Calls for more wells to be installed in developing and impoverished nations;
12. Further requests water filters such as sand pits in rural areas;
13. Calls upon funding more water sanitation facilities in impoverished and developing nations;

### **Sharing Resources & Water Resources**

14. Calls upon countries to trade or share water resources;
15. Calls upon willing countries to fund through donations from developed nations by reallocating military funding;
16. Encourages new drip irrigation systems in impoverished and developing countries;
17. Urges willing countries to use their water wisely through programs funded by the UN;
18. Advises willing countries to donate water resources to impoverished and developing countries;
19. Advises countries to trust new and more efficient water systems and resources;
20. Invites farmers to save rain water using gutters, barrels, and reuse it using basic filtration systems;
21. Encourages willing farmers to grow more flood resistant and native plants/crops;
22. Encourages countries to use more greenhouses to prevent floods from destroying crops funded through donations, the UN, or reallocating military spending.
