



Draft Resolution GA/1/1.1

General Assembly First Committee

Co-sponsors: Republic of Azerbaijan, People's Republic of China, Arab Republic of Egypt, Federal Republic of Germany, Republic of Serbia, Republic of Singapore, Republic of Slovenia, Syrian Arab Republic, Oriental Republic of Uruguay, Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.

Topic: Reduction of military budgets

Deeply concerned by the increase of military budgets and emphasizing the need to reduce military budgets,

Taking into consideration countries' military and social goals,

Acknowledging the lack of transparency of military expenditure in certain countries,

Regretting that the sharing of any military related information is regarded as a vulnerability to that country,

Aware of the effect of military spending towards children,

Taking into consideration how children and civilians are affected by the increase of military spending,

Noting with regret that civilians are the most vulnerable during recent conflict,

Noting that civilians are often not aware of their country's military spendings,

Recognizing countries' past and present efforts to reduce negative impact of conflicts,

Deeply conscious of the effect of military budgets on economies globally therefore affecting civilians and government agencies,

Public Relations of Military Budgets

1. Requests countries to make their budgets public for everyone;
2. Designates a part of military budgets to a medical training program for civilians;
3. Urges the immediate action of nations to recalculate military budgets while keeping in mind their people's wellbeing;

4. Encourages the effort of all countries to set aside money from their military budget to introduce faster and safer evacuation procedures for civilians in active war zones;

Prevention of Conflict

5. Endorses countries to set aside money from their military budget to create regional safe zones in case of conflict;

Percentage Reallocation of Military Budgets

6. Calls for the increase of spending for humanitarian efforts using reallocated military budgets;

7. Directs a portion of military budgets based on military size to be reallocated annually;

8. Draws attention to the use of reallocated budgets for improving health care and education;

9. Deplores the unwillingness of member states to work towards fostering trust and confidence between nations;

International Collaboration on Military Expenditure

10. Encourages existing weapons treaties in member states by promoting safety, security, and sustainability;

11. Calls for the formation of a committee to create confidence building measures between nations;

12. Advises member states to cooperate and aid to the goals of this committee and the success of the committee in fulfilling its mission.
