Topic: Pandemic preparedness and response

Deeply concerned by the spread of pandemic,,

Bearing in mind the effects of Covid-19 and a long lock down,

Aware of the lack of essential resources and health institutions especially in rural areas,

Seeking equal distribution of personnel and vaccines in developing regions,

Emphasizing the need for communication between governments, health organizations, and the public,

Considering that countries do not have essential resources for future quarantines,

Recognizing the lack of research about diseases in humans and animals,

Desiring a greater amount of transport for medical equipment globally,

Seeking funding for NGOs surrounding pandemic preparedness,

Prevention of the spread of disease

- 1. Urges member states to seek more affordable prices for vaccines;
- 2. Encourages raising awareness about pandemic preparedness through advertising;
- 3. Recommends travel policies be improved by implementing medical tests and screenings;
- 4. Advises member states to improve pandemic guidelines;
- 5. Invites countries to work together to prevent the spread of disease through testing and quarantines;
- 6. Encourages stricter health precautions in high-risk areas;

Creating effective quarantine and pandemic supply distribution

7. Calls for collaboration between member states in supplying quarantine resources;

- 8. Encourages member states to fund developing nations' medical institutions, supplies centers, and pandemic resources;
- 9. Urges member states to communicate effectively through annual summits concerning pandemic preparedness plans;
- 10. Recommends member states equitably distribute necessary resources;

Preparing the public for potential outbreaks

- 11. Requests further developed nations to distribute medical supplies to developing countries;
- 12. Strongly encourages creating campaigns to spread awareness about possible outbreaks;
- 13. Calls for equitable distribution of medical supplies;
- 14. Further invites the creation and funding of more medical NGOs/INGOs for pandemic preparedness;

Moderating response systems and equipment

- 15. Calls for increased research about diseases in humans and animals;
- 16. Welcomes the donations of further developed member states towards developing nations in need of medical supplies;
- 17. Urges member states to have regularly scheduled meetings and review their pandemic preparedness plan.
