#### **Topic: Engaging boys and young men in gender equality**

Bearing in mind that the world does not know enough about gender equality,

Recognizing that not many schools teach about gender equality,

Noting that women have rights and that they can make their own decisions too,

Fully aware that many women worldwide are abused and neglected,

Deeply concerned that women in some regions are unable to protect themselves,

Recalling the need to spread out the responsibilities of household needs,

Deeply concerned that harmful stereotypes and social norms prevent gender equality,

#### **Gender Education and Community Funding**

1. Emphasizing online programs and games that educate men and boys about gender equality;
2. Encouraging that schools provide mandatory classes about gender equality at an early age for all students;
3. Supports fundraisers to raise money for schools and teachers to educate about gender equality;

#### **Involving Women in Their Own Decisions**

4. Encourages businesses to give micro-loans to women in need;
5. Draws attention to involving women equally and giving them the power to participate in all societies;
6. Calls upon trained educators to improve women and girls' confidence in themselves;
7. Welcoming places for women to talk about their rights and to talk to men about their ideas;

## **Ending Violence Towards Women**

8. Requests resources for women in danger such as safe housing, phone numbers and other emergency contacts;
9. Suggests spreading awareness by informing others about violence towards women;
10. Supports companies that sell affordable self protection products against violence towards women;

## **Solutions to Fight Gender Inequality**

11. Encourages the UN to fund gender equality for all countries;
12. Urges men to engage in roles usually given to women;
13. Draws attention to the need for platforms that encourage conversations and integration between genders;
14. Calls upon men to join UN Women, educate themselves, and spread awareness about gender equality;
15. Requests resources for men and boys to learn, in a safe space about gender equality;
16. Emphasizes the need for posters, advertisements, campaigns, and protests that encourage gender equality.
