

Resolution UN WOMEN/2.1

UN WOMEN Committee

Topic: Women's meaningful participation in peace processes

Noting further inclusive and equitable peace negotiations,

Noting with regret the lack of women's participation in peace processes globally,

Fully aware of the absence of policies and laws that support women's empowerment and participation,

Fully believing an improvement on women's voting rights, reproductive rights, education, economical aid, and legal protection nation wide is essential to achieving gender equality,

Fully concerned by the absence of financial aid for women who are interested in engaging in peace participation,

Alarmed by the minimal effort put into education dedicated to supporting women in governmental positions,

Noting with deep concern that women everywhere are affected by conflict based on their gender,

Bearing in mind that all members of society are essential in the making of progress in women's empowerment,

Participation

- 1. Strongly encourages the organization of protests to promote women's participation in a peaceful way;
- 2. Requests the support and encouragement for women that run for governmental/political positions;

- 3. Calls upon charities to help support women's empowerment;
- 4. Further Requests promoting, enforcing, and monitoring gender equality in peace negotiations;
- 5. Invites collaborations with organization and influential people, both male and female to ensure women empowerment;

Protection

- 6. Suggests promoting data collection techniques based on gender equality;
- 7. Draws the attention to shaping peace and leadership at all levels;
- 8. Calls upon governmental institutions to ensure women's empowerment and participation;
- 9. Invites strengthening political security and development activities for women worldwide;
- 10. Deplores for the addition of information and targets the Sustainable Development Goals;
- 11. Advises strengthening national statistical systems;

Finance and Education

- 12. Advises for educational programs both online and in person to support women's participation in peace processes;
- 13. Urges developed institutions to provide financial aid, for all causes dedicated to women empowerment and their participation in governmental positions;
- 14. Requests the creation of charities that help support women in peace participation;
- 15. Suggests free training for women who are volunteers of peace participation, thus giving them the opportunity to improve their skills as peace negotiators and world shapers;

Influencing our Community

- 16. Encourages establishing laws and policies about gender equality;
- 17. Further invites the use of social media to promote women's empowerment and its role in society;
- 18. Calls for the international community to understand how crucial women's empowerment is;
- 19. Accepts using digital platforms to promote positive messages on gender equality;
- 20. Invites news stations and media platforms to cover stories on women's empowerment;
- 21. Instructs building a more inclusive and equitable society;
- 22. Draws the attention to organizing influential rallies led by inspiring role models.
