#### **Topic: Children and armed conflict**

Deeply disturbed that countries are not aware of children getting recruited to war,

Noting with regret that globally one out of five children are living in armed conflict,

Noting with regret that there are very few safe spaces for children and their families during armed conflicts,

#### **Children should live in safe spaces especially ages 1-18**

1. Strongly advises that safe spaces have good resources and learning environments;

#### **Safe areas to support children and families affected by war**

2. Heavily recommends to have the NGO's funding to establish camps and some of the military budget to fund children's needs;
3. Calls upon the UN to make safe civilians spaces are never used for war and always protected;

### **Ensuring the health of children**

4. Calls for providing humanitarian aid to families affected by war;
5. Affirms relocating children to safe areas such as bunkers and camps during armed conflicts;

### **Strengthening international law enforcement**

6. Encourages international cooperation to help get refugees to camps;
7. Emphasizes that countries need to stop non-state armed groups which violate the rights of children.
