### Topic: Human Rights and Climate Change

Acknowledging the importance of reducing greenhouse gas emissions and the inefficient use of energy,

Noting with deep regret the amount of recyclable material thrown into the landfill,

Aware of how essential products that use energy in production are important for human survival,

Noting with regret that humans actions are the cause of climate change,

Deeply disturbed by the bad air quality that humans produce in many places,

Deeply concerned by how greatly climate change has disrupted farming and agricultural,

### Energy

1. Endorses the idea of clean energy used in transportation that uses gas;
2. Urges countries to implement renewable energy such as hydropower, solar, and wind;

3. Recommends the expansion and creation of engineering programs that develop and research renewable energy;
4. Urges corporations to increase usage of renewable energy solar, hydro, and wind;

### **Infrastructure**

5. Emphasizes the importance of utilizing indigenous knowledge about climate change;

### **Agriculture**

6. Calls upon member states to begin large scale composting projects to decrease landfills and prevent them from getting too big and polluting oceans and the quality of the air;
7. Proposes the need for the globally connected agricultural system for countries suffering the effects of climate change;

### **Reduction**

8. Emphasizes the importance of public global climate awareness and fulfilling the Paris Agreement;
9. Calls upon action to repair the Ozone layer and use solar and wind power to reduce fossil fuel;
10. Invites the implementation of programs with environmentally sustainable policies.
