#### **Topic: Advancement of Women**

Acknowledging stereotypes are a big problem for women around the world,

Realizing how gender discrimination affects women,

Noting that women are not getting the same rights as men,

Expressing concern about women's opportunities,

Aware of how males are harassing females,

Taking note that women don't get the same access to healthcare as men,

Realizing how women don't get the same voting rights as men,

Conscious of how women don't get to choose who they marry in some countries,

Recognizing how women get affected by domestic violence,

### **Equality, Rights, and Opportunity**

1. Advises people to contribute to funding programs to help women get opportunities around the world;
2. Calls upon governments to make stricter laws against sexual violence, partner violence, and other forms of harassment;

### **How and Why the UN Should Act**

3. Suggests that the UN ensures that these actions like domestic violence by talking to the government to make stronger laws;
4. Recommends training the officers to stop sexual assault;
5. Further invites the UN acting for equal rights;
6. Acknowledges providing education for pregnant mothers in need;
7. Recommends they shall take action for families and equal education;
8. Strongly suggests providing resources for women's education;
9. Advises funding for equality for women;

### **Monetary**

10. Demands that women receive equal job opportunities;
11. Requests all nations to have equal pay between both genders;
12. Calls upon all countries to reduce taxes for single parents;
13. Advises that countries set up microfinancing programs targeted at education;
14. Urges that countries raise the minimum wage of all genders;
15. Further urges that all member states reduce the pay gap between men and women;
16. Instructs that all countries promote equal workplace opportunities;

### **Education Rights**

17. Requests all member nations to provide funding/fundraising for women seeking higher education;
18. Requests putting daycares inside of schools;
19. Calls upon the UN and member states to fund women reaching for higher education;
20. Calling upon member nations around the world to teach positive masculinity.
