### Topic: Refugee and Migrant Health

Having considered free therapy for refugees and migrants,

Taking into account refugees safety,

Welcoming all refugees and migrants,

Fully convinced that everyone should have a house,

Taking into account refugees safety and warzones,

Fully believing that refugees and migrants should have good healthcare,

Acting fast to give migrants proper healthcare for their needs,

Considering building more hospitals that are closer to each other,

Desiring migrants to have the same healthcare as the citizens in that country,

Desiring an education program for refugees and migrants,

Declaring a summit on education for refugees and migrants,

Seeking to educate refugees and migrants about their basic human rights.,

### **Global Refugee and Migrant Health and Mental Health**

1. Acknowledges the health of refugees and migrants;
2. Draws the attention to all refugee healthcare;
3. Calls upon the U.N. to provide proper healthcare and use money from the U.N. to build hospitals for refugees and migrants, and food banks for refugees and migrants;

### **Migrant and Refugee Safety**

4. Support safety of refugees and migrants regardless of their gender and race;
5. Considers having more camps around areas in need;
6. Calls upon charities for refugee and migrant health;

### **Shelters and Health Clinics for Migrants**

7. Adopts mobile health clinics;
8. Encourages accepting registered migrants to hospitals;
9. Advises building camps/clinics on country borders;
10. Calls upon building camps in places without healthcare;

### **Education**

11. Calls upon more refugees to be educated;
12. Further invites more refugee and migrant children to be enrolled in school;
13. Strongly encourages the education and resources for migrants and refugees;
14. Requests that refugees and migrants get the same education as citizens of the country.
