Human Rights Council Committee

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Topic: The Human Rights of Migrants

Fully aware that migrants' rights are being violated,

Emphasizing the need for stable security and more worldwide agreements for migrants' rights,

Aware of human trafficking, poor identification and documentation of migrants due to chaotic mismanagement of immigration procedures,

Alarmed by the poor working conditions and exploitation of migrants' rights in the workforce,

Recognizing the importance of providing housing for migrants,

Emphasizing the need to educate migrants of all ages,

International Policies and Agreements

1. Recommends the further adaptation of media and technology to spread awareness and education;
2. Insists on further protection of migrants and natives against discrimination by cross cultural communication;

3. Expresses hope to ensure migrant and refugee safety by granting them asylum and improving migrant access to proper housing;
4. Further invites governments to enhance transparency and communicate on objectives to help migrants;

Integration into Society for Migrants

5. Recommends the spread of awareness on programs where families can sign up to host migrants, helping them integrate into society;
6. Strongly encourages states to provide translation services catering to the social needs of new migrants and lessons in the local language to assist their subsequent integration into society;
7. Advises that employers treat migrant workers with equality;

Migrant Safety

8. Calls upon other Member States to adopt stable and secure rules to protect migrants against exploitation and discrimination, with assistance from the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees;
9. Strongly encourages governments and organizations to protect the livelihoods of migrants by enforcing labor laws and ensuring equal pay;
10. Adopts stricter rules to identify and prevent human trafficking in workplaces by enhancing security;

Standardized and Secure Immigration Procedures

11. Requests the establishment of an integrated system across borders holding biometric data and identifying information digitally to prevent documentation fraud and identity loss of migrants;
12. Urges intensified international cooperation to dismantle trafficking networks that exploit regular migration pathways and undermine legal immigration;
13. Encourages countries to adopt a digitalized system to distribute migrants based on their needs, skills, and abilities.
