### Topic: Refugee and Migrant Health

Noting that climate change can affect migration,

Deeply concerned that refugee camps are overcrowded,

Deeply disturbed by the discrimination, abuse and the problems of assimilation of migrants and refugees,

Realizing the complications of migrant and refugee registration,

Noting with deep concern the unsafe feelings of migrants and refugees,

Keeping in mind that due to the lack of funding, refugees and migrants are not getting the healthcare, food and water they need,

Cognizant that the digital health systems negatively affect refugees and migrants who are dealing with PTSD, anxiety and trauma,

Deeply concerned that foreign diseases are being transmitted by air, food, and water to refugees and migrants,

## **Diseases, Hygiene and Health**

1. Encourages charities to donate to refugees and migrants;
2. Advises people to be aware of food and water problems;
3. Suggests special camps focused on food, water and medical health;
4. Invites member states to provide transport all over the world to take migrants and refugees to the nearest country with better technology centers and healthcare;

## **Lack of Human Rights**

5. Calls for specialized programs for refugees and migrants to support their well-being;
6. Expresses its hope for stronger and safer digital health systems;
7. Declares accordingly that there could be specialized programs for migrants and refugees to help with their mental illnesses, as well as being provided with specialized therapists and doctors;
8. Urges delivering supplies to migrant refugees' camps;

## **Environmental Issues**

9. Requests building bigger and stronger houses for refugees and migrants;
10. Encourages building larger camps for migrants and refugees where everyone is treated properly;
11. Advises donating for refugees and migrants;
12. Calls for countries to put drones with cameras to locate refugees and migrants;
13. Considers making more refugee and migrant camps in isolated areas and offering free sessions of therapy;

## **Unfair Treatment**

14. Strongly encourages free language lessons offered by the host country for migrants and refugees;
15. Expresses its hope to host yearly festivals, in which migrants and refugees collaborate in building lasting bonds.
